REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE

To apply for admission to the International Degree program, you must have:

- A cumulative grade-point average of at least 2.75 in your college work;
- At least 32 credit hours of college-level courses completed; and
- Foreign language competency equivalent to two years of study at the college level (e.g. SPAN 213) with a 3.0 GPA in language courses

If the foreign language competency is to be shown by completion of courses at an institution other than OSU, submit a transcript from that school indicating the completion of the second-year foreign language sequence. You may also show competency by providing the results of an equivalency test administered by the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures (FLL) at Oregon State University.

Individual departments may have additional requirements for admission to the program, so check with your major department for more information.

EVALUATION PROCESS

Once the completed application is received by the International Degree Program, it will be reviewed for accuracy and to ensure that the minimum requirements have been met. If you are admissible under the minimum requirements of the International Degree, notice will be forwarded to your major department, which will determine if you meet departmental standards for the program.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE

Once the department has approved your acceptance into the program, you will receive a letter from the Office of International Degree & Education Abroad indicating your status in the program. Notification should take about one month from the time you submit your application. At that time, you will need to sign the “Change of Undergraduate Academic Program” form and submit it to the Registrar’s Office.
