EDUCATION ABROAD (2010-11)

The data shown in this section includes students who earn credit for studying or interning outside the U.S. The majority of students went abroad for 1-2 quarters. More women (62% study abroad, 72% internship) participated in these programs than men. Approximately 80% of participants identified themselves as Caucasian, the other 20% included 1 African American, 1 American Indian, 32 Asian & Pacific Islanders, 20 Latinos, 14 Biracial participants, and 17 students declined to respond. "EA Credit" details the percentage of graduates between Summer 2010 and Spring 2011 who earned credit for education abroad while enrolled at OSU.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARS & FACULTY (2010-11)

In addition to the faculty grant and award information, the data below represents international faculty, visiting scholars, and student interns who required ISFS visa and immigration services. Nearly half (46.9%) of this population were post-doctoral researchers on exchange visas; 22.9% were student interns engaged in a short-term research experience; 21.6% were faculty on temporary work visas; and 3.8% are faculty for whom OSU is applying for permanent residency.

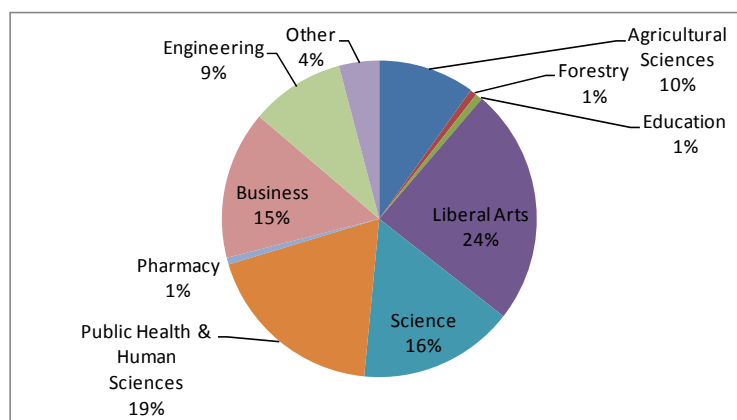

The ID Program
