Of the 98 countries represented by students at OSU, two-thirds of all international students at OSU are represented by four countries: China (1208), Saudi Arabia (473), South Korea (155) and India (102). The remaining top ten countries are Japan (80), Taiwan (72), Iran (66), Thailand (65), Kuwait (59) and Indonesia (55).

EDUCATION ABROAD (2011-12)

The numbers shown in this section include students who earn credit for studying or interning outside the U.S. Over half (56%) of all study abroad participants went abroad for one term and over one quarter (27%) went abroad for less than one term. 93% of all students identified themselves as Caucasian or Caucasian + another identity. 24.5% of all students identified themselves as non-Caucasian, Caucasian + another identity or international. "EA Credit" shows the percentage of graduates between Summer 2011 and Spring 2012 who earned credit for education abroad while enrolled in their respective colleges at OSU.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARS & FACULTY (2011-12)

In addition to the faculty grant and award information, the data below represent international faculty, visiting scholars, and student interns who required ISFS visa and immigration services. The majority of this population (75%) was on exchange visas, engaged in research or some type of internship; 19% were faculty on temporary work visas; and 2% are faculty for whom OSU is applying for permanent residency.

Western Europe continues to be most popular with 56% of all participants. One-fifth of all participants went to Latin American/ Caribbean, a decrease (-37%) compared to last year. Asia 10%, Oceania 8%, Eastern Europe 4% and Sub-Saharan Africa 3%, Middle East/ No. Africa <1%

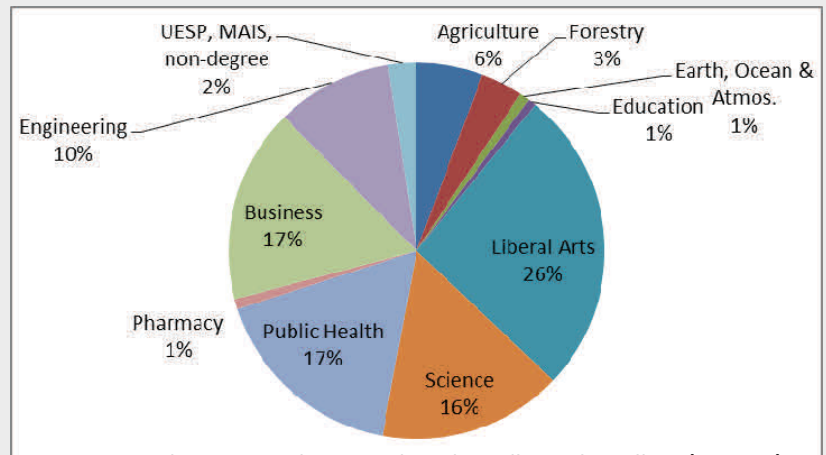

The Division of Liberal Arts and Science are home to 60% of participants. One-third of all ID students enrolled are also in the University Honors College and over one-fourth (28%) of all ID alumni have earned an Honor's degree. Enrollment in the INTL 407 Thesis course increased by 50% compared to last year.
